

How are the explosion-proof electrical distribution boxes in New Zealand

Explosion-proof electrical distribution boxes in New Zealand must comply with AS/NZS 60079 standards, be installed by licensed personnel, and be suitable for the classified hazardous area. Regulatory Requirements In New Zealand, all electrical installations, including those in hazardous areas, must comply with the Electricity (Safety) Regulations 2010 and associated safety standards, ensuring protection for users, the public, and property (WorkSafe New Zealand). - Hazardous Area Classification:** Areas are classified into Zones 0, 1, 2 (gases) and Zones 20, 21, 22 (dust) to determine the level of protection required.
- Protection Methods:** Includes flameproof (Ex d), intrinsic safety (Ex i), and increased safety (Ex e) techniques.
- Inspection and Maintenance:** Periodic inspections must follow AS/NZS 60079-17 to ensure ongoing safety.
- Equipment Marking:** Clear labeling is required to indicate suitability for the specific hazardous zone.

- Enclosure Selection:** Use IEC Ex certified enclosures, such as stainless steel (316SS) or IP66/IP67 rated boxes, suitable for the specific zone and environmental conditions.
