Ground-mounted boxes should also be slightly elevated, typically 2 to 4 inches, to prevent moisture damage. Ensure the location is dry, well-ventilated, and away from direct water exposure.

Industrial or Large Spaces In industrial facilities or large commercial spaces, the height may be adjusted for operational convenience, but consistency across multiple boxes in the same area is important. The center of operation is usually positioned between 1.2 meters and 1.6 meters to allow standing access without ladders. Concealed or wall-embedded boxes may have slightly different heights, often around 1.3 to 1.5 meters, depending on the box size and wall configuration.

- Safety:** Keep the box away from wet areas, heat sources, and high-traffic zones to prevent damage or hazards.
- Standards Compliance:** Follow local and international standards such as IEC 60364-5-52 or BS 7671 for installation height and spacing.
