High-Speed Transmission Achievements Japan has set multiple world records in optical fiber communication. In 2025, researchers at the National Institute of Information and Communications Technology (NICT) achieved 1.02 petabits per second over 1,808 kilometers using a newly developed 19-core optical fiber, marking the fastest long-distance transmission ever recorded. Earlier, in 2024, NICT achieved 402 terabits per second using existing fiber infrastructure, covering all transmission bands (O-, E-, S-, C-, L-, and U-bands) with advanced amplification technologies. These breakthroughs demonstrate Japan's ability to maximize both capacity and distance in fiber optic networks.

Nationwide Fiber Network Expansion Japan has invested heavily in Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) networks, making high-speed broadband widely available. Major operators like NTT DOCOMO, KDDI, and SoftBank have integrated fiber optics to support ultra-fast internet and 5G networks, particularly in urban and indoor environments where high-frequency signals struggle to penetrate. This strategic deployment ensures low-latency, high-capacity connectivity for both consumers and businesses.

Next-Generation Optical Infrastructure To address the growing demand for data and energy efficiency, Japan is developing the Innovative Optical and Wireless Network (IOWN). This next-generation infrastructure converts electrical signals to optical signals, aiming for 100 times greater power efficiency, 125 times higher transmission capacity, and drastically reduced latency compared to conventional systems. IOWN is already being tested at Expo 2025 in Osaka, connecting multiple facilities with near-zero latency and enabli...
