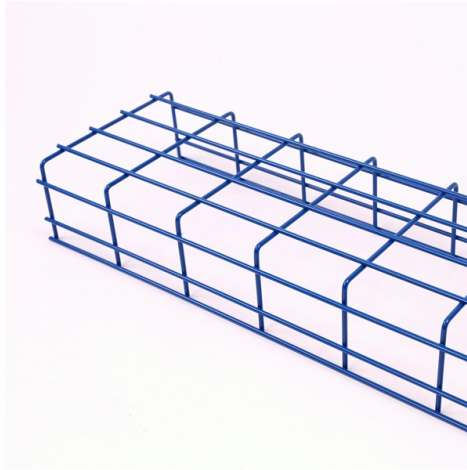


How many live wires are in the distribution box

Single-Phase Distribution Box In a standard single-phase residential setup, the distribution box usually has one live (L) wire, one neutral (N) wire, and one protective earth (PE) wire. - RCDs or RCBOs may also be included to protect against earth faults, requiring proper connection of live, neutral, and earth wires.

Neutral and earth wires are present in both systems for safety and proper circuit operation. The exact number of live wires depends on the type of electrical system and the load requirements of the building.
