

How to build a home fiber optic network

- Connectors:** LC connectors with UPC polish (blue) are standard for home networks.
- Protective Jackets:** Use riser-rated cables indoors; for outdoor runs, choose UV-stable jackets like TPU.
- Tools:** Fiber stripper, cleaver, splicing device, and connectors are essential. Safety gear like gloves and glasses is recommended.

Step 4: Run the Fiber Cables Drill holes or use existing conduits to route cables through walls or underground. Secure cables every few feet to prevent sagging or bending, as excessive bending can damage fibers. For outdoor runs, ensure cables are protected from UV exposure and moisture.

Step 5: Connect to Networking Equipment Terminate the fiber at the ONT or media converter provided by your ISP. Connect the ONT to your router or switch to distribute the network throughout your home. Use patch cables to link devices to the network, ensuring proper connector alignment.
