

How to calculate the length of optical cable longitudinal planing splices



Overview

Reel count is $\text{ceil}(\text{Total} \div \text{ReelSize})$, and the rounded order length equals $\text{Reels} \times \text{ReelSize}$. Choose your unit and keep it consistent. Set routing slack to cover bends and alignment. Enter cable distance, per-km loss at your operating wavelength, connector pairs, splices, splitter and other component losses, plus transmitter power and receiver sensitivity. We compute the total cable attenuation, link loss budget, and the system performance margin you have left after the repair. Fiber optic cable reel length planning is one of those LLD details that gets treated like an afterthought — right up until a project manager calls asking why the splice count doubled from the estimate. I've seen it happen on FTTH builds in rural Mississippi, on middle-mile routes through the hill. A tool that computes how many fibers fit in a circular bundle and splits them into user-defined segments for cable-assembly planning. Fusion Splice: A fusion splice is a fiber optic splice made by perfectly aligning the fiber to be spliced, and then applying enough heat to fuse the glass ends together. Typical loss for a fusion splice is less than 0.
