Ports may be labeled "PoE" or "PoE+", indicating support for standard (15.4 W) or higher power (30 W) per port. The switch label or manual often lists the total power budget. Using PoE Testing Tools Tools like LinkSprinter can test if a port is delivering proper PoE voltage and validate network connectivity at the device end. Testing at the wall jack ensures the powered device receives sufficient voltage, accounting for cable loss.
