Use the correct Ethernet cable from the ONT to the router's WAN port. Check router settings, especially if your ISP requires a static IP or specific VLAN configuration. Seek ISP Assistance If you are unsure about compatibility or the connection still fails, contact your ISP. They can provide the correct ONT, verify the fiber type, and ensure your r...
