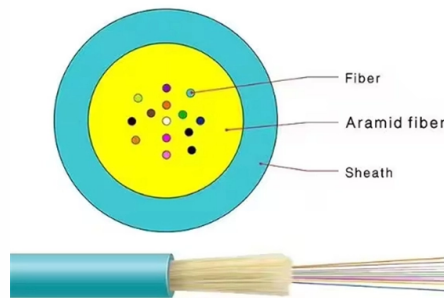


How to connect a 50-pair cable junction box
