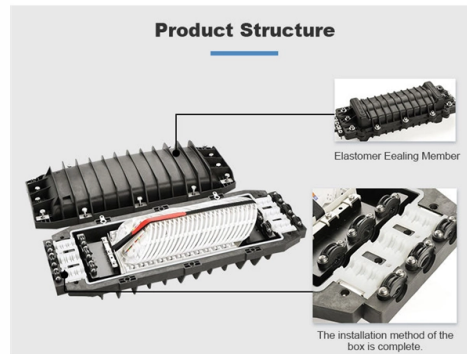


How to connect a Layer 2 switch



AI Overview

To connect to a Layer 2 switch network, you need to configure the switch ports as access or trunk ports, assign VLANs, and connect your devices to the appropriate ports.

Understanding Layer 2 Switch Ports

Layer 2 switches operate at the data link layer and forward frames based on MAC addresses. Each port can be configured as:

- Access Port:** Connects a single device (like a workstation or server) to a specific VLAN. It carries traffic for only one VLAN.
- Trunk Port:** Connects switches or network devices to carry traffic for multiple VLANs simultaneously, allowing VLANs to extend across the network.

Connecting Devices

- Identify the VLAN:** Determine which VLAN your device should belong to. VLANs segment the network logically, isolating traffic between groups of devices.
- Configure the Port:** On the switch, configure the port as an access port for a single VLAN or a trunk port if connecting to another switch or VLAN-aware device.
- Connect the Device:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect your device to the configured port. Each LAN port is treated as a separate collision domain, allowing full bandwidth access in full-duplex mode.

MAC Address Learning: The switch dynamically learns the MAC addresses of connected devices and forwards frames accordingly. If needed, you can configure static MAC addresses to bind a device to a specific port.

Ensuring Proper Communication

- Full-Duplex Mode:** Enable full-duplex on ports to allow simultaneous sending and receiving of data, doubling effective bandwidth.
- Avoid Loops:** Use protocols like Spanning Tree Protocol (STP) to prevent Layer 2 loops if multiple switches are interconnected.
- VLAN Tagging:** For trunk ports, ensure VLAN tagging is consistent across switches to maintain proper traffic separation.

Optional Advanced Steps

- Security Group Tags (SGTs):** In networks using Cisco TrustSec, Layer 2 interfaces can enforce security policies and inspect traffic based on SGTs.
- Load Sharing and Flow Control:** Some switches support flow control and load balancing to optimize traffic across multiple ports.
