

# How to connect a junction box and router to the network

You can safely connect a router to a junction box by providing power through properly wired electrical connections and routing network cables through the box while following safety standards.

**Step 1: Prepare the Junction Box** Choose a junction box that fits your installation environment (indoor, dry location for a router) and is large enough to accommodate the wires and connectors. **Step 3: Routing Network Cables** Use Ethernet cables (Cat5e or Cat6) to connect the router to your network. Run the Ethernet cable through the junction box using a cable clamp to prevent strain or damage. Ensure the cable is not pinched or bent sharply inside the box. Connect the Ethernet cable to the router's WAN or LAN port as required.

**Step 4: Final Checks** Verify all electrical connections are secure and insulated. Ensure the junction box cover is installed and accessible. Turn the circuit back on and test the router for power and network connectivity. Confirm that the router is functioning properly and that the cables are not under tension.

**Safety Tips** Always turn off power before working on electrical wiring. Use a voltage tester to confirm wires are not live. Avoid overfilling the junction box; overc...
