

How to connect and ground a distribution box

3. Connect the box to the mounting plate: Attach one end of the ground wire to the threaded stud or grounding point on the box and the other end to the mounting plate. Ensure the connection is tight and the contact area is sufficient for a low-resistance path .
4. Connect the mounting plate to the central ground: Run a second ground wire from the mounting plate to the factory or building's central grounding point or a properly installed ground rod. This ensures all system parts are effectively grounded .
5. Ground internal components: If the distribution box contains electrical components that require grounding, connect them to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures safe operation of all internal equipment .
6. Verify resistance: The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm. For longer tool cables or multiple spindles, consider parallel grounding wires to maintain low resistance .
7. Test the grounding: Use a voltmeter or ground resistance tester to confirm that the grounding is effective. If the resistance is too high, adjust the number or placement of ground rods .
8. Mark and maintain: Clearly label all ground...

How To Ground The Distribution Box

The metal box itself should be processed with a "box grounding bolt" (with PE mark), which must be connected to the grounded PE bus with a copper core wire or a special braided soft wire;

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
