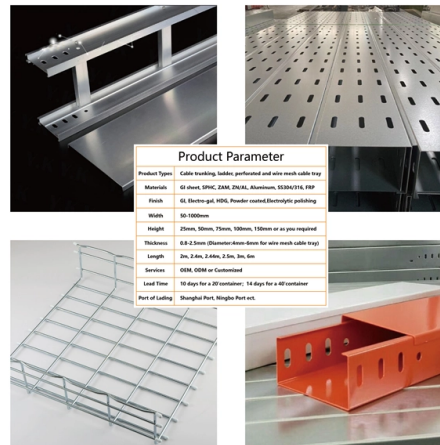

Avoid Overlaps: Ensure cable tray ends do not collide without connection, as this can create short segments or extra nodes that degrade performance.

Maintain Spacing: Keep at least 10 cm between trays for air jumps and visibility of segments.

Check for Duplicates: Remove fully or partially duplicated parts to prevent errors in routing and fill rate calculations.

Assign Systems: Group connected trays into systems (e.g., power, lighting) to maintain consistent appearance and behavior across the network.

Using CAD Blocks and Components

Dynamic Blocks: Use pre-made CAD blocks for ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom trays, including fittings like elbows, tees, and reducers.

Integration: Insert blocks into your drawing to save time and ensure accurate placement. Adjust properties such as rotation, stretch, or mirror as needed.
