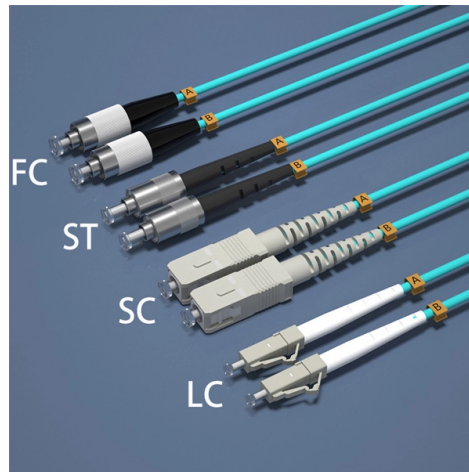


How to connect fiber optic cable to network cable on the panel
