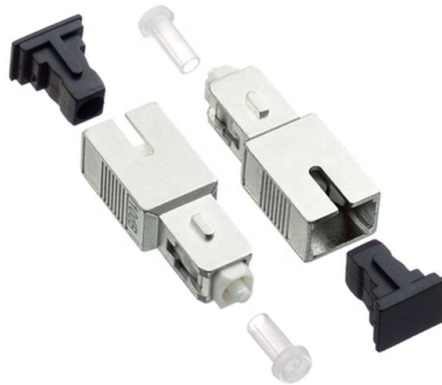


How to connect fiber optic cables in a computer room
