

How to connect fiber optic cables to a network panel

Attach Connectors: Use connector kits or fusion splicing to join fibers. Fusion splicing provides a permanent, low-loss connection, while mechanical connectors allow easier reconfiguration.

Connect to Network Panels: Insert the terminated fiber into the panel ports, ensuring the connector clicks securely. Match the fiber type and connector type to the panel specifications.

Connect to ONT or Router: For network access, plug the fiber into the ONT, which converts optical signals to electrical signals. Then connect the ONT to a fiber-ready router using an Ethernet cable.
