

How to connect temporary cables to the distribution box

Step 4: Arrange and Secure Wiring Neatly arrange wires inside the box, avoiding tangling or contact with sharp edges. Use zip ties or cable clamps to secure cables and leave space for heat dissipation (). Keep power and lighting circuits separate, and locate outlets close to the working area to minimize long trailing cables ().

Step 5: Grounding and Protection Ensure the distribution box and all circuits are properly grounded. Install circuit breakers or fuses with correct ratings to protect against overloads and short circuits (). Label each circuit clearly and maintain a circuit diagram inside the box for reference ().
