

How to connect the fiber optic splice filler tube

The splicer will generate an electric arc to melt and fuse the fiber ends together, creating a continuous optical path .Inspect the splice for estimated loss; a high-quality singlemode splice should have a loss of 30 mm during handling .Use manufacturer-recommended splice tubes and consumables to ensure long-term reliability .Double-check that the splice filler tube fully covers the joint and is properly heat-shrunk to prevent water ingress or mechanical damage .

By following these steps, the fiber optic splice filler tube will provide mechanical strength, environmental protection, and long-term stability for your fiber network.
