

How to connect the grounding terminal block to the distribution box



Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be $< 1 \Omega$. At its core, a grounding terminal block does one simple but essential job: it creates a reliable, low-resistance connection between all the individual components in a cabinet and the main grounding point. This connection is typically made right through the metal DIN rail it's mounted on. Learn how to connect equipment grounding conductors to receptacles and keep their continuity in boxes. DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
