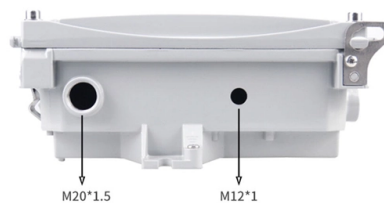


How to connect the terminal box for fiber optic splicing



Overview

Most FTTH termination boxes use pigtails (pre-connectorized fiber tails). A fiber pigtail is a specific hardware connection used for cable termination. Thus, a fiber termination box is used to terminate the optical fiber. Installing a fiber optic termination box is one of those jobs that looks simple on paper, but it's easy to do poorly in the field. A box can be mounted perfectly and still fail later because fibers were routed too tightly, splices were stacked incorrectly, or the cable entry was never properly. A fiber termination box is the standard instrument used in fiber optic networks to connect, secure, and protect optical fibers at the terminating point. It functions as a junction between the incoming fiber cable and the outgoing customer-side fiber cable, where one fiber can be spliced, patched. It is used in a terminal box to connect the optical fibers in the optical cable, and to connect the optical cable and the jumper through the terminal box coupler (adapter). Proper installation and maintenance of FTBs are essential to ensure the reliability and performance of the network infrastructure.
