- Configure Physical Interfaces** Connect the core switch to distribution switches using high-speed uplinks (10G, 40G, or higher depending on traffic needs). Ensure proper cabling and port modules are installed for optimal throughput.
- Set Up VLANs** Create interconnection VLANs on the core switch to segment traffic between different network areas. Assign VLAN interfaces (VLANIF) and bind them to the appropriate VPN instances if isolating public and private traffic.
- Configure Routing** Enable Layer 3 routing on the core switch to allow communication between VLANs and subnets. Implement dynamic routing protocols such as OSPF or BGP to propagate routes across the network and toward external networks. Ensure that routing policies do not overload the core switch with complex packet inspection, keeping it focused...
