

How to install a tray-type cable tray

Step 4: Install the Trays Align trays carefully, connecting sections with couplers or splice plates. Maintain proper spacing between runs (6–9 inches for ladder trays) and ensure trays are level. Handle materials carefully to avoid coating damage, especially for galvanized or painted trays.

Step 5: Lay and Secure Cables Place cables in the tray according to fill limits (typically 40% for power cables, 50% for control cables) and maintain separation between high-power and low-power circuits to prevent interference. Use cable ties or clamps to secure cables without over-tightening.

Step 6: Grounding and Bonding Metallic trays must be properly grounded to serve as equipment grounding conductors. Ensure all bonding and grounding requirements are met according to NEC Article 392 and local regulations.
