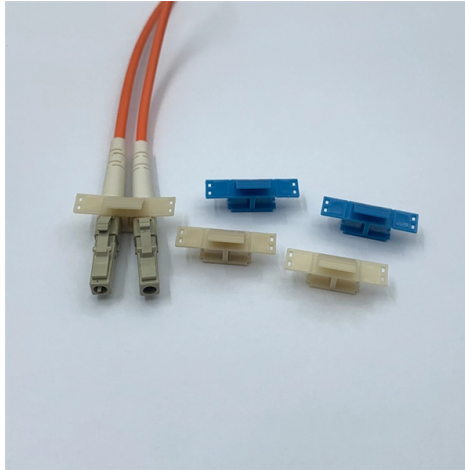


How to install a wall bracket for a fiber optic router

Attach the mounting bracket to the rear of the router and align the four mounting holes on the mounting bracket with the tapped holes on the router.
