

How to install protective sleeves on cable trays

Use a small amount of silicone spray or lubricant if necessary to ease insertion without damaging the sleeve.

Step 4: Secure the Sleeving Position nylon cable ties at both ends and every 30-50 cm along the sleeve for longer runs. Avoid over-tightening to prevent damage to cables or the sleeve. Trim excess tie tails for a neat finish. Optionally, use end caps or heat-shrink tubing to protect the edges of the sleeve from fraying.

Step 5: Install on the Cable Tray Lay the sleeved cables along the tray, maintaining proper spacing and bend radius as recommended for your cable type. Ensure the sleeve does not pinch or compress the cables, which could impair electrical performance. For outdoor or exposed installations, verify that the sleeve m...
