

How to install the circuit breaker in the distribution box

Follow color coding standards (black/red for hot, white for neutral, green/bare for ground) and ensure all connections are tight.

Wire Management Route wires neatly within the enclosure. Use cable ties to secure wires and leave space for heat dissipation. Avoid sharp edges that could damage insulation.

Label the Circuit Clearly mark the breaker with the circuit it controls (e.g., "Kitchen Outlets" or "Living Room Lights") for future maintenance and troubleshooting.
