

How to plug in the fiber optic socket panel

6. Connect the Fiber to the Socket Insert the pigtail connector into the adapter in the wall socket. Snap the faceplate onto the back box to secure the connection .
7. Connect the ONT or Router Use a fiber patch cable (matching connector type, e.g., SC/APC to SC/APC) to connect the wall socket to the ONT or fiber-ready router .
8. Test the Connection Measure light levels to ensure proper signal strength. For GPON, ideal levels are between -27 dBm and -8 dBm. If loss exceeds -27 dBm, recheck splices and connections .
9. Dust and Slack Management Always cap unused ports to prevent contamination. Leave approximately 50cm of slack fiber coiled inside the box for future maintenance .
