

How to split wires at the junction box



Overview

While junction boxes are useful for creating connections, they are not designed to split circuits. Proper wire splicing within this enclosure is necessary to ensure the long-term reliability of the electrical system and prevent the risk of fire from loose. Romex, formally known as NM-B (Nonmetallic-Sheathed Cable Type B), is the standard electrical cable used in most residential wiring applications. This cable consists of two or more insulated conductors—typically a black hot wire, a white neutral wire, and a bare copper ground—all encased within a plastic sheath. In this article, you'll learn how to splice a single gang junction box. A single gang electrical box (one gang box) is where electricians install a switch, plug, or thermostat! We splice wires in the box to carry on power (junction box), or use switch legs to turn a light on or off. You'll learn.
