Step 5: Advanced Testing with OTDR An Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) can detect faults along the fiber's length: It sends pulses of light and measures reflections to locate breaks, bends, or splices. This method is ideal for complex networks or when precise diagnostics are needed.
