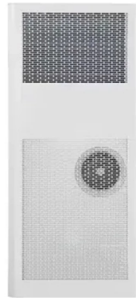


How to tie a small optical fiber cable

For mechanical connectors, ensure the fiber aligns with the pre-polished stub and fill the gap with index-matching gel.
- Secure and Finish**
Slide the outer housing over the connector and align any bump marks for proper orientation. Crimp or tighten the ferrule as needed depending on connector type (push-pull, threaded, or bayonet twist-lock). Clean the end face again and place a dust cap to protect it.
- Optional Fusion Splicing**
For permanent connections, use a fusion splicer to melt two fiber ends together. Typically, a short pre-connectorized pigtail is spliced onto the cable to provide a factory-quality connector.
- Test the Connection**
Insert the fiber into the network device (router, switch, or transceiver) ensuring the connector clicks securely. Use a fiber tester or optical power meter to check for signal loss and verify proper connectivity.

Safety and Best Practices
Always work in a clean, dust-free environment. Handle fiber shards carefully; dispose of scraps in a sealed container....
