High bias current or low TX power after cleaning and reseating may suggest the module or fiber is nearing end-of-life.

Step 5: Identify Environmental or Internal Faults Check for environmental factors such as temperature fluctuations, humidity, or airflow issues that can affect module performance. Inspect the module for physical damage, burn marks, or poor solder joints. If abnormal parameters persist, replace the suspected...
