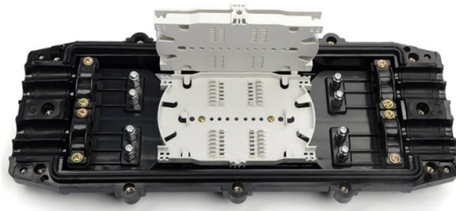


How to use Singapore explosion-proof electrical distribution boxes

Terminal Connections: Connect incoming power supply cables to the designated terminal blocks, ensuring correct connection of live, neutral, and earth wires. Verify connections with a multimeter or continuity tester.

Sealing: Secure cable glands and terminal covers tightly to maintain the explosion-proof integrity of the box.

Usage Precautions

Do Not Open Live Boxes: Never open the cover while the power is on, especially in hazardous environments.

Protect Joint Surfaces: Avoid scratching or damaging explosion-proof joint surfaces during maintenance. Apply anti-rust oil after maintenance and secure covers with screws and washers before use.
