

How to wire a three-level distribution box



AI Overview

A three-level distribution box should be wired by correctly identifying phases, connecting live, neutral, and earth conductors, and following hierarchical distribution from main to secondary and tertiary boards.

Phase Identification and Wiring In a three-phase system, there are three live phases (L1, L2, L3), a neutral (N), and a protective earth (PE). Standard color codes are: Phase 1 – Brown, Phase 2 – Black, Phase 3 – Gray, Neutral – Blue, and Earth – Green-and-Yellow. The incoming supply is connected to the main switch or MCCB, with each phase connected to its respective terminal. Neutral and earth conductors are connected to their designated busbars. Proper labeling of each phase and terminal is essential for safety and maintenance.

Hierarchical Distribution A three-level distribution system follows a main → secondary → tertiary hierarchy:

- Primary/Main Distribution Board:** Receives power from the utility and distributes it to secondary boards.
- Secondary Distribution Boards:** Branch circuits supply multiple tertiary switch boxes.
- Tertiary Switch Boxes:** Each switch box controls a single piece of equipment or socket, following the “one machine, one switch” principle. No equipment should bypass levels to maintain system integrity.

Load Connections

- Single-phase 220V loads:** Connect one phase, neutral, and earth.
- Three-phase 380V loads:** Connect all three phases plus earth; neutral is added if local control is required.
- Two-phase 380V equipment (e.g., welding machines):** Connect any two phases plus earth.

Installation Guidelines Distribution boxes should be firmly fixed, horizontally and vertically aligned, with minimal gaps around the enclosure. Wall-mounted boxes require expansion bolts or embedded wood bricks for secure installation. Maintain short distribution distances: main board near the power source, secondary boards near concentrated loads, and tertiary switch boxes within 30 meters of the secondary board and 3 meters of the controlled equipment. Ensure environmental safety: dry, ventilated, and accessible locations, with proper IP/NEM...
