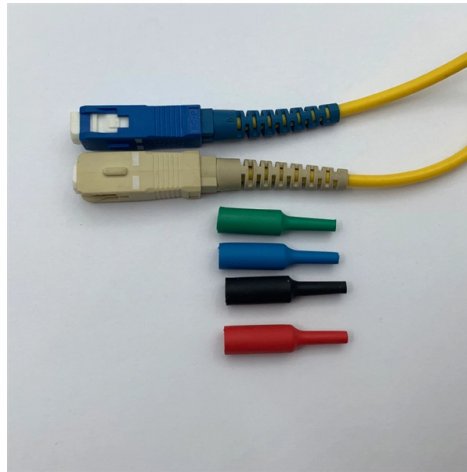


How to wire the patch cord in the fiber optic junction box

Avoid crossing, hanging, or coiling the cable across multiple spools; each patch cord should be coiled on a single spool if needed (). Keep the installation neat and organized to allow easy maintenance and future upgrades.
6. Connect the Patch Cord
Insert the connector into the designated port until it clicks securely. Ensure SC/APC and SC/UPC connectors are not cross-mated due to incompatible endface geometry ().
7. Label the Patch Cord
Label both ends of the patch cord with machine-printed labels showing the optical path name, code, and barcode. Proper labeling ensures traceability and reduces troubleshooting time ().
8. Test the Connection
After wiring, test the optical path using an optical power meter...
