

Industrial power distribution box socket connection

To connect an industrial socket to a power distribution box, ensure proper cable selection, correct terminal connections (L1, L2, L3, N, Earth), and follow safety procedures including power isolation and secure mounting.

Step 1: Safety First Before starting, isolate power from the distribution board or circuit you will work on to prevent electric shock or short circuits. - Cable size:** Use appropriately rated conductors based on load; typically 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for higher loads. Ensure insulation is rated for industrial use.

Step 3: Prepare the Wiring

- Strip insulation:** Strip the insulation carefully without damaging copper strands.
- Use ferrules or lugs:** Use ferrules or lugs if recommended for secure terminal connections.
- Color-code wires correctly:** Phases (L1, L2, L3), Neutral (N), and Earth (E).

Step 4: Connect to the Distribution Box

- Single-phase socket:** Connect Phase (L) to the outgoing MCB terminal, Neutral (N) to the neutral link, and Earth (E) to the earth link.
- Three-phase socket:** Connect L1, L2, L3 to the outgoing terminals of a 3- or 4-pole MCB, Neutral (if required) to the neutral terminal, and Earth to the earth link.

Step 5: Mount the Socket

- Secure the socket:** Mount the socket to a panel or wall using appropriate screws and alignment. Ensure the socket is stable and accessible for equipment connection.

Step 6: Inspection and Testing

Perform a safety check before energizing the circuit. Verify that all connections are correct and secure.
