

Inspection time for secondary distribution boxes



Overview

The SFG20 44-07 standard requires specific 6-monthly checks that include visual inspections for physical damage, verification of proper labelling, checking protective devices, identifying overheating issues, and ensuring overall functionality of distribution boards. 1 The EICR schedule of inspections follows the BS 7671 Appendix 6 model form and covers six main sections: distribution equipment, wiring systems, current-using equipment, protective measures, isolation and switching, and miscellaneous items. 2 Each item in the schedule is marked as satisfactory. This utility procedure classifies maintenance tasks for miscellaneous electric overhead (OH) and underground (UG) equipment, including capacitor banks, fault indicators, interrupters, reclosers, voltage regulators, Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and Primary Distribution Alarm and.
