Properly ground the distribution box and all metal components to prevent electrical hazards. Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed with no visible gaps to maintain explosion-proof integrity. Use galvanized fasteners and neatly arrange wiring with nylon ties or enameled tin for layered distribution.

Safety and Maintenance Do not open the box cover while the power is on, especially in hazardous areas. Protect explosion-proof joint surfaces during maintenance; avoid scratches and apply anti-rust oil after servicing. Regularly inspect the box for component damage and ensure the explosion-proof rating matches the hazardous area classification (e.g., Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 21, Zone 22).
