- 3. Cable Management and Fiber Protection**
Proper cable management is critical. Fiber bend radius should be maintained above 40 mm to prevent signal loss or damage. Splice trays, mechanical or fusion splices, and PLC splitters should be organized to allow easy access and future expansion. Insulation between metal components and the box shell is required to prevent electrical interference or damage.
- 4. Technical and Safety Compliance**
Ensure the use of UL/CE-certified components and compliance with local standards for fiber optic installations. Each fiber circuit should be properly terminated, labeled, and protected. Visual inspections and testing with appropriate tools should be performed before powering the network.
