

Installation and positioning of switches in a three-level distribution box

- 4. Wiring the Switch** Identify the incoming hot (line) wire, neutral, and ground. Use pigtailling to split the incoming hot wire to feed each switch terminal individually. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar in the distribution box. Connect the ground wire to the grounding bus bar. Each switch should interrupt only the hot conductor, leaving neutral and ground continuous.
- 5. Connect to the Load** Run the outgoing wire from each switch to its respective load. Ensure that each switch controls only one device, following the “one machine, one switch” principle.
- 6. Final Checks** Verify all connections are tight and insulated. Ensure proper labeling of switches and circuits for future maintenance. Perform a visual inspection and test with a multimeter before restoring power.
- 7. Compliance and Maintenance** Follow local electrical codes (NEC...
