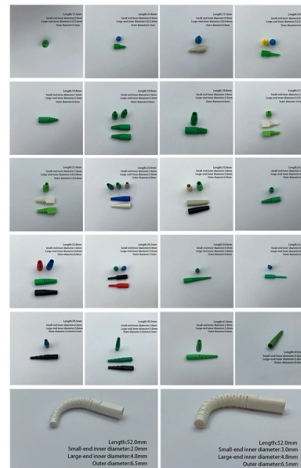


Installation height of computer room power distribution box
