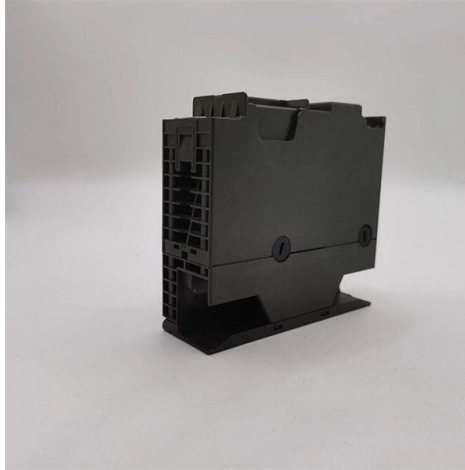


Installation method of cable tray support

Common Support Methods

- 1. Wall-Mounted Cantilever Brackets**
Cantilever brackets are attached directly to walls to support cable trays along vertical surfaces. Threaded rods are anchored into the structural ceiling, and a horizontal Unistrut channel or trapeze bar is attached between the rods to create a shelf for the tray. Nuts and washers are used to level the support. This method is suitable for long horizontal runs and allows for easy access and maintenance.
- 3. Floor or Structural Supports**
In some industrial settings, cable trays may be supported by floor-mounted stands or structural beams. These supports are less common but provide stability for heavy cable loads or where wall and ceiling mounting are impractical.

Support Spacing and Alignment

Spacing: Typical support intervals range from 1.5 to 3 meters (5–10 feet), depending on tray type, load, and manufacturer specifications. Ladder trays may require closer spacing for heavy power cables, while perforated trays for lighter loads can have wider intervals.

Leveling: Supports must be aligned and leveled to prevent sagging, which can damage cables or reduce current-carrying capacity. Use a laser level or chalk line to mark the tray path before installation.

Bends and Elevation Changes: Mark locations for tees, bends, or risers in advance. Supports should be installed at these points to maintain structural integrity and proper cable routing.
