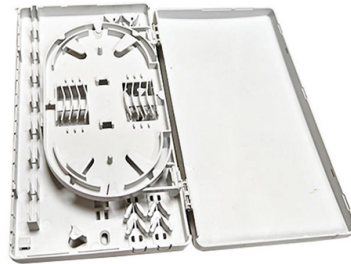

Use internal clips or guides to secure the cables and prevent kinks or sharp bends. Terminating the Fiber Strip the outer jacket, buffer, and coating carefully using a fiber stripper. Cleave the fiber ends perpendicularly with a fiber cleaver and clean them to remove dust or debris. Connect the fiber to adapters or splice trays inside the box according to the manufacturer's instructions. Connecting Devices Use fiber optic patch cables or pigtails to connect the junction box to ONTs, routers, or other network devices. Ensure all connections are tight and properly seated to minimize signal loss. Testing and Maintenance Test the connection using a fiber optic power meter or visual fault locator to verify signal integrity.
