Position and Align Spanner Wires: Work from top to bottom, aligning each spanner wire to evenly distribute the load across the bridge deck. Suspenders should be vertically adjustable to accommodate minor alignment corrections and to reduce oscillations under live loads ().

Secure with Hardware: Use wedge sockets, clips, and sleeves to fasten the wire securely. Ensure all fasteners are tightened according to manufacturer specifications and that the wire is free of kinks or twists (). Safety harnesses and fall protection are mandatory when working at height ().

Tensioning and Testing: Gradually tension each spanner wire to the design specifications, checking for uniform load distribution. Inspect for proper alignment, secure attachments, and any signs of stress or deformation. Modern projects may use data analytics to monitor tension and predict maintenance needs ().
