AI Overview

- Overheating or Power Supply Limitations:** Switches may reduce PoE output to protect internal components if overheating occurs. Similarly, an underpowered or failing power supply can limit available PoE.

Troubleshooting Steps

- Check Port Status and Power Allocation:** Use commands like `show power inline` (Cisco) or `show poe controller` (Juniper) to verify which ports are powered and the power consumption per device.
- Verify Device Requirements:** Confirm the PoE class and wattage requirements of connected devices and ensure the switch supports them (PoE, PoE+, PoE++).
- Adjust Port Power Limits:** Remove or increase static power limits on ports to allow devices to draw sufficient power.
- Test with Known Good Devices and Cables:** Swap devices or cables to rule out hardware faults or cabling issues.
- Re-enable or Flap Ports:** Disable and re-enable the port (no shutdown or set interface x/x/x disable/enable) to reset PoE negotiation.
- Monitor Switch Power Budget:** Ensure the total PoE load does not exceed the switch's maximum budget. P...
