

Is single-mode fiber optic cable fitted with a heat fusion splice



Overview

Virtually all singlemode splices are fusion. Fiber optic joints or terminations are made two ways: 1) splices which create a permanent joint between the two fibers or 2) connectors that mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the fiber to a piece of network gear. Either joining method must have three primary characteristics. Fiber splicing means joining two optical fibers (permanently or temporarily) such that light guided in one fiber and reaching the joint (splice) can be transferred into the second fiber with low insertion loss. It details the crucial requirements for achieving high-quality splices with losses as low as 0.02 dB. Multimode fibers can be harder to fusion splice as the larger core with many layers of glass that produces the graded-index profile are sometimes harder to match up, especially with fibers of different types or manufacturers. Fusion splicing may be done one fiber at a time or a complete fiber.
