Distribution Box Wiring

A distribution box (also called a breaker box or panelboard) is the central hub that receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple circuits. Key wiring considerations include:

- Placement and Accessibility:** Install in dry, ventilated areas, away from water, flammable substances, and corrosive materials. Residential boxes are typically mounted around 1.5 meters above the floor for easy access.
- Circuit Protection:** Each outgoing circuit should have its own breaker or fuse to prevent overloads and short circuits. Include a main switch to disconnect all power during maintenance.
- Wire Sizing:** Use wires rated for the expected load of each circuit. Proper gauge selection prevents overheating and ensures compliance with electrical codes.
- Grounding and Bonding:** Connect all metal parts and the neutral bus to a proper ground to prevent electric shock and ensure system safety.
- Cable Management:** Route wires neatly, secure them with ties, and avoid sharp bends. Label each circuit for easier maintenance and troubleshooting.
- Testing:** Before powering on, verify connections with a multimeter and check insulation resistance to ensure no faults.

Lighting Box Wiring

Lighting boxes (junction boxes for lights) distribute power to fixtures and switches. Key points include:

- Box Selection:** Choose boxes rated for the number of wires and fixtures. Metal boxes require grounding; plastic boxes are non-conductive but still need proper support.
- Circuit Connections:** Connect the incoming hot (live) wire to the switch and then to the fixture. Neutral wires are connected directly to the fixture. Ground wires must be bonded to the box and fixture.
- Wire Routing:** Avoid overfilling boxes; follow the maximum fill capacity specified by code. Use wire clamps to secure cables entering the box.
- Switch Loops:** For single-pole switches, run the hot wire from the distribution box to the switch, then to the fixture. For multi-way switch...
