Performance Monitoring Monitor cable performance using tools like OTDR (Optical Time Domain Reflectometer) to detect insertion loss, signal degradation, or faults along the fiber path. Establish baseline measurements during initial deployment to compare against future readings, enabling condition-based maintenance rather than reactive repairs. For mobile networks, periodic testing should focus on critical links and high-usage cables, with more frequent checks in harsh or variable environments.
