Manufacturer-specific jumpers may be required for proper fit and safety. Connect Securely: Attach the jumper to the terminals or connectors, ensuring a firm and reliable connection. For electrical jumpers, tighten screws or clamps; for fiber jumpers, insert connectors into adapters. Organize Routing: Use troughs, split rings, or cable guides to route jumpers neatly, avoiding sharp bends, kinks, or excessive pulling that could damage the conductor or fiber.
