Rotating or circular applications, such as on robots, revolving tables, or medical equipment, require cable carriers designed for motion:

- Twisterband:** Compact, modular cable carrier capable of rotating up to 3,000 degrees in minimal space. Ideal for high-speed rotation and tight installation areas. Cables are guided with minimal wear, and crossbars snap open for easy replacement.
- Twisterchain:** Rugged carrier suitable for circular or spiral motion up to 540 degrees, supporting high rotational speeds (up to 13 feet per second). Modular design allows easy cable replacement and adapts to space-restricted applications.
- Standard Energy Chains:** Can be used for rotary motion up to 450 degrees. They are low-cost and simple to install but require longer lengths and careful mounting to avoid excessive stress on brackets.
