Depth/Side Rail Height: Typically 50 mm to 150 mm, depending on tray type and load requirements. Ladder trays often prioritize side rail height for structural strength.

Length: Standard straight sections are usually 3 meters (10 feet), facilitating transport and installation.

Rung Spacing: For ladder trays, spacing is generally 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) to balance support and airflow.

Material Thickness: Varies by tray type and load; thicker materials increase load capacity and reduce deflection. Common steel thickness ranges from 1.5 mm to 3 mm, with aluminum and stainless steel options for corrosion resistance.
