

Moving the fiber optic cable reel



AI Overview

Fiber optic cable reels must be moved upright using proper lifting equipment, secured during transport, and stored indoors to prevent damage and maintain cable integrity. Safe Handling and Lifting Fiber optic cable reels are often heavy and fragile, so manual lifting is not recommended for large reels. Use a forklift, reel mover, or crane with a spreader bar to lift the reel upright, ensuring the fork or lifting chains do not contact the cable jacket directly. Always lift from the triangular openings or designated lifting points on the reel, and avoid dropping the reel from any height. For smaller reels, a two-person lift may be sufficient, but care must be taken to maintain the reel upright and avoid twisting the cable. Transportation During transport, reels should be secured to prevent rolling or tipping. Use tie-downs or bolted mounts to keep the reel stable on vehicles or carts. Avoid laying the reel on the FORJ connector exit side, as this can damage the connectors. If unloading from a vehicle, use a tail-lift, elevator, or mechanical aid to prevent the reel from dropping. Always follow the roll direction arrows on the reel to prevent over-spinning or reverse tension, which can cause cable squirting or damage. Storage Fiber optic reels should be stored indoors in a dry, UV-protected environment to prevent environmental damage. Avoid areas with excessive humidity, heat, chemical exposure, or risk of falling objects. Wooden reels should have flange bolts hand-tightened before storage or deployment to maintain structural integrity. Storing the cable on the reel ensures the minimum bend radius is maintained and keeps the cable off the ground. Deployment Preparation Before paying out the cable, cut the cable tail to about one foot to allow free movement from the feed hole. Ensure the reel is secured to a solid surface using bolts or clamps, and check that any spring rewind or drum mechanisms are properly tensioned without exceeding recommended rotations.
